- (1) **COMM 480: Topics in Media;** 3 cr. Advanced, innovative or exploratory work in media production or a detailed investigation on a topic of current interest in digital media and broadcasting.
- (2) **DESN 332: Material Design;** 3 cr. Explores material and surface pattern design as a creative endeavor while developing and reinforcing technical and conceptual skills. Elective courses for department majors.
- (3) **ENTR 370: Media Entrepreneurship;** 3 cr. W Focuses on the major steps needed to create a for-profit or nonprofit communication-based enterprise. Intended for students in the Entrepreneurship Minor.
