New Undergraduate Programs

- 1. Minor in Science Writing: Proposal to create new minor; "a minor in science writing could be applied to many work environments. According to CASW, science writers are employed by not only the mass media but by universities and corporations to write magazine articles, news releases and other reports on research in their respective laboratories...."
- 2. Bachelor of Science in Manufacturing Engineering Technology: Proposal to create a new major designed to provide an in-depth technical content of advanced manufacturing with emphasis on automated manufacturing, robotics, computer aided drafting and design and computer integrated manufacturing (CIM).
- **3. Bachelors of Arts in Earth Sciences/Geology Option:** Proposal to create a new major option intended to give transfer students flexibility while pursuing their degree. It focuses on geology and will allow students to pursue licensure as a Professional Geologist.
- 4. Bachelor of Science in Geology/Environmental Geology Option: Proposal to add an "Environmental Geology" option to the BS-Geology major; roughly 80% of geology graduates take jobs in environmental consulting, so this degree option is designed to give them the skills needed for those jobs (in addition to making them eligible for professional licensure). If this proposed degree option is approved, the current BA-Earth Sciences/Environmental Geology option would be eliminated.
