### **General Education Vote Results**

- Round #01 03/27-03/29
  - Voting Breakdown:
    - Adopt New Gateway Model 43.9%, 87 votes
    - Adopt New Journey Model 28.3%, 56 votes
    - Retain Existing GenEd Program Model 27.8%, 55 votes

#### • Details:

- The response rate was 69%.
- Based on the voting protocol approved at faculty senate:
  - No option received 50% + 1 of voting faculty, therefore no model is adopted with this vote.
  - This results in a runoff vote between the two top choices: Adopt New Gateway Model and Adopt New Journey Model

### • Round #02 – 04/03-04/05

- Voting Breakdown:
  - Adopt New Gateway Model 63.2%, 117 votes
  - Adopt New Journey Model 36.8%, 68 votes
- Details:
  - Response Rate 65%
  - Based on the voting protocol approved at faculty senate:
    - The Gateway Model received more than 50% + 1 of voting faculty, therefore the model is adopted with this vote.
