The physical and symbolic presence of each of the fraternity and sorority groups of the National Pan-Hellenic Council, Incorporated (NPHC), collectively referenced as the "Divine Nine," will be represented on Memorial Walkway, along with Greek organizations of the National Multicultural Greek Council Inc. (NMGC) and the National Association of Latino Fraternal Organizations, Incorporated (NALFO).
