Members of the **Hobbs-Wickersham Society** make an impact for future students through planned gifts. The name of the Hobbs-Wickersham Society recognizes two leaders who were instrumental in founding what today is Millersville University: Reverend Lewis M. Hobbs and Dr. James P. Wickersham.
