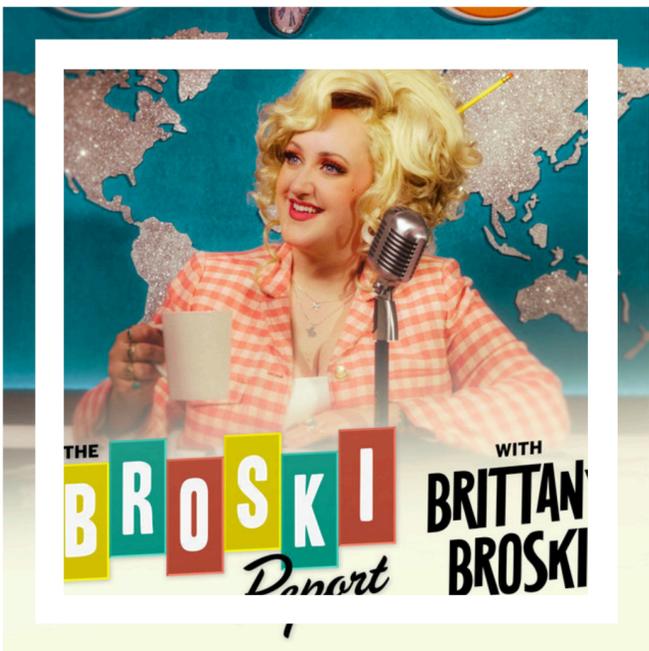

After graduation, Donovan plans to attend Medical School next Fall to become an Emergency Physician.

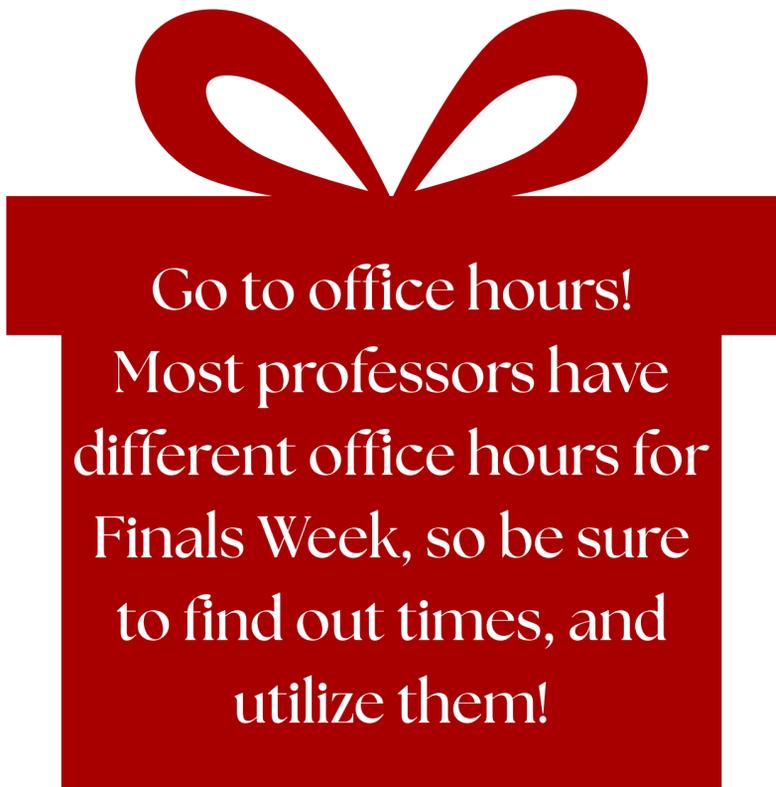

# Finals Week Tips and Tricks!

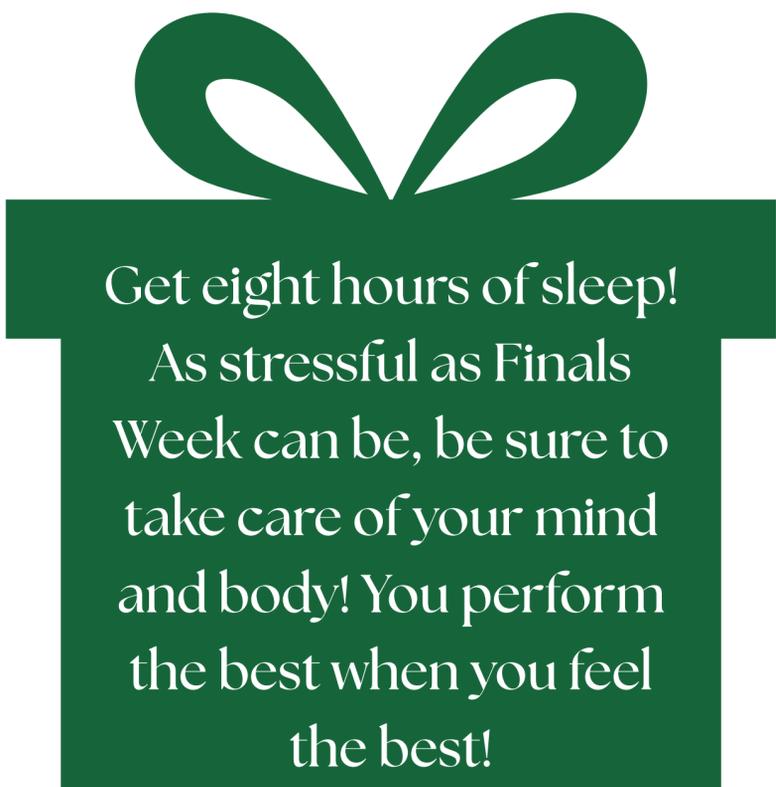
Finals Week is upon us, but it's important to remember to take care of yourself during this busy time!
