The Honors College takes on NYC!



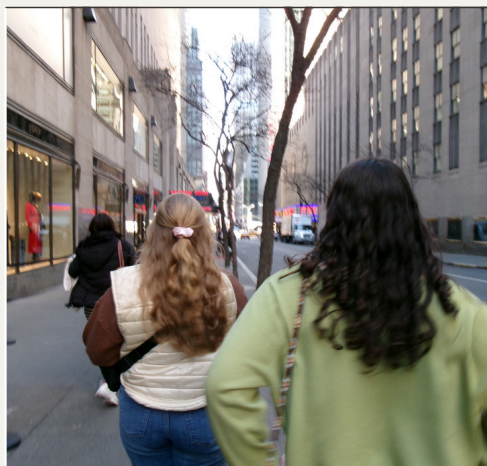
On March 1st, the Honors College went on their annual trip to NYC! Students spent the day shopping, sightseeing, and saw “Wicked” on Broadway!

Mentorship Conference

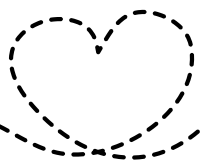
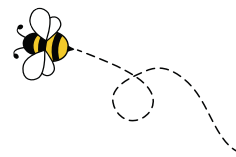

Sabela Zablackis

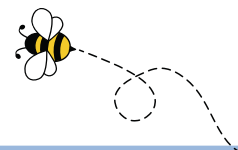
Major- Biology

Jessica Dieckman

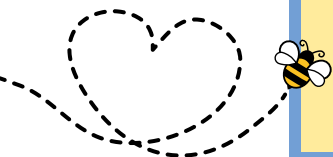
**Major- Mathematics
