

Fall 2020 College of AHSS Required Courses Pass/Fail Grading Scale

Undergraduate students will be allowed in Fall 2020 to convert courses in which they are currently enrolled to a Pass/Fail grading scale.

BEFORE CHOOSING THE P/F GRADE, STUDENTS SHOULD BE AWARE OF THE RESTRICTIONS AND MINIMUM GRADE REQUIREMENTS THAT REMAIN IN EFFECT.

- **PREREQUISITES AND CORE DEGREE REQUIREMENTS.** The “P” grade will **NOT** fulfill prerequisites or degree requirements in courses that require a minimum grade. You are strongly encouraged to contact your academic advisor before making final grade decisions.
- **STUDENTS ON ACADEMIC PROBATION/WARNING, OR WITH A GPA BELOW 2.0.** You may opt for a letter grade in a bid to raise your GPA. While the P/F option will not affect GPA, it may affect graduation plans. It may also impact financial aid. Email the financial aid office for more information.
- **EDUCATION MAJORS.** We strongly advise **AGAINST** P/F for any required course. If you select this option, you will need to retake the course for a letter grade later, as P is not an acceptable grade in any required course in a certification program. Moreover, the Pass/Fail option may have unintended outcomes related to employability and readiness for the field upon graduation. Consult your academic advisor.
- **GRADUATING SENIORS.** If you have completed all of your graduation requirements by the end of Fall '20, the minimum grade rule will not apply. You may use your P grades from Fall 2020 for any program or course requirements, including any courses that require a specific minimum letter grade.
