# AHSS FELLOWSHIP 2023-24

# **INVITATION FOR APPLICATIONS**

This fellowship awards a scholarship to support one student per year.

### Criteria of eligibility/expectation:

- 1. Rising junior or senior.
- 2. Majoring in a program housed in the College of Arts, Humanities and Social Sciences.
- 3. Financial need as determined by the Office of Financial Aid.
- 4. Intends to pursue a <u>high-impact learning opportunity</u> during the summer before their junior or senior year.
- 5. High-impact practices include, but may not be limited to: study abroad, competitive internship, artist/musician residency, and research projects.
- 6. Earn academic credit for the learning opportunity.
- 7. Students must work with a faculty mentor (you will need to have faculty write a Statement of Faculty Support\* to accompany your application).
- 8. Funds can be used for the tuition needed for the learning opportunity in the summer and to supplement the student's tuition costs in the following fall.
- 9. After completion of the high-impact opportunity, the Fellow will be expected to prepare a report about their activities to be included in AHSS annual report, make a presentation at a public venue determined in consultation with the faculty advisor and the dean's office, and meet with AHSS Advisory Board and donors as invited.

## Timetable:

- 1. Applications, along with Statement of Faculty Support are due no later than April 17, 2024.
- 2. Please submit to <u>AHSS@millersville.edu</u>.
- 3. A college-wide committee appointed by the dean will review applications and make a recommendation.
- 4. The awardee will be announced by the dean no later than May 1, 2024.

\*Statement of Faculty Support: The faculty mentor should provide a brief statement of support including an evaluation of the student's academic standing, the feasibility of the project, and the likelihood of achieving intended outcomes.
