

AHSS grant program for faculty-led study trips
2021-22

Purpose: To provide funding for faculty-led student trips that offer unique learning experiences and high impact activities for students majoring in Arts, Humanities and Social Sciences in 2021-22 academic year. The program will fund domestic trips organized by the faculty for groups of students (including student clubs) in order to contribute to the learning goals of a particular course or curriculum. These learning experiences can include, for example, field trips, attendance at events, participation in conferences.

Total amount available: \$27K per year divided into two installments of \$13,500 for Fall'21 and for Spring'22 and Summer'22.

Application: Faculty organizing the trip should submit: 1) a 1-page, 500 word description of the trip, including the purpose, rationale, dates, and destination; 2) budget.

Deadlines: For trips taking place between September 15-December 30, 2021 applications will be accepted starting on September 7. For trips taking place between January 1-June 30, 2022 applications will be accepted starting on December 15.

Approval: The funding will be allocated by the Dean on the "first come, first served" basis until all the funds have been allocated.

Amounts: Funding awards will not exceed \$3000 per trip.
