AHSS grant program for faculty-led study trips 2022-23

Purpose: To provide funding for faculty-led student trips that offer unique learning experiences and high-impact activities for students majoring in Arts, Humanities, and Social Sciences in the 2022-23 academic year. The program will fund domestic trips organized by the faculty for groups of students (including student clubs) to contribute to the learning goals of a particular course or curriculum. These learning experiences can include, for example, field trips, attendance at events, and participation in conferences. The grant does not fund meals.

The total amount available: \$30 K per year divided into two installments of \$15,000 for Fall 2022, and for Spring and Summer 2023.

Application: Faculty organizing the trip should submit: 1) a 1-page, 500-word description of the trip, including the purpose, rationale, dates, and destination(s); 2) budget.

Deadlines: For trips taking place between September 15 to December 30, 2022, applications will be accepted starting on September 7, 2022. For trips taking place between January 1 to June 30, 2023, applications will be accepted starting December 15, 2022.

Approval: The funding will be allocated by the Dean on a "first-come, first-serve" basis until all the funds have been allocated.

Amounts: Funding awards will not exceed \$3000 per trip.
