

2014-15 Review of *Our BOLD Path* Potential Change of Course Items to be endorsed by Cabinet

Suggested change of course items are based upon review of KPIs, discussions at summer 2015 Cabinet retreats with the Strategic Planning Steering Committee, and input from the October 23, 2015 meeting of the Strategic Advisory Council.

Goal A: To Engage Learners.

Changing the metric to include documented expenditures of support from outside grants.</p>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Increase civic engagement through a new graduation requirement that requires students to engage in at least 2 out of 6 high impact learning opportunities, such as undergraduate research, service learning, internships or study abroad. 	<p>Background: Proposed to drop “increase civic engagement” focus and how reference the “graduation requirement”.¹</p> <p><u>Revised Strategy:</u> Emphasize engagement in at least two high-impact learning opportunities (such as such as undergraduate research, service learning, internships or study-abroad) by graduation.</p> <p><u>Revised Target:</u> In consultation with the Academic Policies Committee, consider making at least two high impact learning opportunities a graduation requirement for all students.</p>
