


Marauder Suite (single rooms)

FUNDING YOUR EDUCATION

MERIT-BASED SCHOLARSHIPS

All first-year undergraduate international students are automatically eligible for merit scholarship consideration. Awards for the Fall 2025-Spring 2026 academic year will be set by October 2024. Scholarship eligibility is based on a US 4.0 weighted GPA.

GRADUATE ASSISTANTSHIPS (GA)

A tuition waiver of 18 credits per year and a stipend of \$6,000 per year are awarded to fulltime, first-year GAs. Part-time graduate assistantships would work 10 hours per week in the position and receive half of the tuition waiver and stipend.

CAMPUS EMPLOYMENT

International students may work on campus up to 20 hours per week while enrolled, with a potential to earn between \$1,920 and \$9,600 annually depending on position, hours and shifts worked.

TUITION PAYMENT PLAN

Plans break down your tuition balance into three to five affordable monthly payments. There's no interest, payment options are flexible, setup fees are affordable and it's easy to enroll! There is a \$30 nonrefundable enrollment fee per semester.

^{**}The English Language Institute does not charge tuition; instead, there is a Program Charge.

Achieve a qualifying score on a recognized **English language proficiency test**:

- Full Admission UG: 70 iBT, 6.0 IELTS, 105 Duolingo, 50 PTE, 169 Cambridge, 4.0 iTEP, 2A STEP-EIKEN
- Full Admission G: 81 iBT, 6.5 IELTS, 115 Duolingo, 58 PTE, 177 Cambridge, 4.5 iTEP, Pre-1 STEP-EIKEN

SEMESTER START DATE

International students are eligible to begin their program of study in the fall (August) or spring (January) semester each year.
The academic year begins in the fall semester.
Master of Social Work students only begin their studies on campus during the summer 1 term (May).



^{*}Copies are acceptable for issuing an admission decision, but official copies from the issuing institution are required for enrollment. External evaluation not required.
