

OFF-CAMPUS HOUSING OPTIONS

Read the following information carefully in order to make your decision. If you choose to live ON-campus, a room will be guaranteed and reserved. If you chose to live OFF-campus, it is your responsibility to secure your housing. NO room will be reserved for you in the Residence Halls.

ALL Millersville University freshman and any students with fewer than 60 credits must live on campus.

General Information

- A room will not be reserved for you in the on-campus residence halls as a backup option if your apartment arrangements do not go as planned.
- There are a number of shared local apartments within walking distance to campus.
- If you decide to live in an apartment, you will be responsible for contacting your landlord, arranging your deposit payment which will be due before you arrive in the US, your check-in day, obtaining furniture, finding roommates, etc.
- Meals:
- o If you are in the apartments, you will be responsible for cooking meals on your own. If you would like, you may purchase an MU meal plan for commuting students so that you wouldn't have to cook every meal and you could grab meals on campus in between classes, to eat with friends, etc. By living off-campus, you will be considered a commuting student.
- o If you wish to purchase a meal plan, inform IPS so the office can assist you closer to the start of the semester in adding a plan to your student account

HOUSING OPTIONS

1. Student Lodging, Inc.

- Student Lodging, Inc. is the only off-campus housing that is affiliated with Millersville University. Students also find other apartments in the area not linked to Student Lodging Inc. Keep in mind that these apartments are all <u>unfurnished</u> so you would be responsible for purchasing and transporting furniture once you arrive.
- Student housing is located adjacent to the campus
- After earning at least 30 credits, you can explore their housing options such as <u>Brookwood Court Apartments</u> and <u>Healthy</u> Living Apartments

2. <u>Immerse International</u>

- A multicultural community where international students can thrive in personal relationships, professional development, and spiritual formation. Immerse is a conservative organization connected with spiritual values and they have some guidelines within the house that may or may not suit your personal preferences.
- Not officially associated with MU
- Most rooms are double occupancy with a limited number of single rooms available
- Leases are 12 months, but shorter terms can be arranged upon request
- 25% of the residents are American students that have expressed interest in making friendships with internationals

3. Manor House Apartments

- Apartments can be found in the vicinity of Millersville University's campus
- Manor House offers one-, two-, and three-bedroom apartments with options for fully furnished apartments
- The complex comes with several amenities like a community swimming pool, 24/7 fitness center, and community center

4. Millers Crossing Apartments

- Apartments can be found in the vicinity of Millersville University's campus
- The complex comes with different amenities like a tennis court, community swimming pool, and fitness center

Please note that there are more housing options available near Millersville University that are not listed above.
