Who is an "International" Applicant?

Identifying a student during the admissions process

Millersville University considers international applicants students who entered or plan to enter the United States on a non-immigrant visa (e.g., F-1, J-1, H-1b, etc.) and maintain non-immigrant status (e.g. Temporary Protected Status (TPS)) throughout their study at Millersville University. This includes those who have submitted residency application documents to USCIS, but have not received formal approval verifying that they have become a permanent resident of the United States of America.

Domestic (or U.S.) applicants are students who are United States citizens, permanent residents of the United States ("Green Card" holders), asylees, refugees, parolees, or those in any other categories not addressed above.

(Once enrolled at MU, all students are welcome to all events held by International Programs & Services.)

Questions to ask:

- "Thank you for stopping by, as we have a few different admitting offices I would like to ask you one or two quick questions to make sure I'm directing you to the right office."
