This is an 18 credit minor with two required courses and four electives. At least two courses must be at the 300 – 400 level. Minimum GPA of a 2.0 required. Only one course that counts toward a major may be counted toward the minor. No courses required for the minor may be taken pass-fail. Courses that count toward the minor are also eligible to be used to satisfy general education requirements. Those requirements are noted in parentheses. At least half of the course work required for the minor must be completed at Millersville.
