The Outlining Method

Dash or indented outlining is usually best except for some science classes (physics/math).

Method -

- ✓ Listening and writing in points in an organized pattern
- ✓ The information which is most general begins at the left with each more specific group of facts indented with spaces to the right.
- ✓ The relationships between the different parts is carried out through indenting.
- ✓ Can use numbers, letters, or Roman numerals

Advantages - Well-organized system if done right.

Disadvantages - Requires more thought in class for accurate organization...

When to Use - If the lecture is presented in outline organization. This format can be most effective when your note taking skills are super sharp.

Example of outline method:

Extrasensory perception
