ONLINE DEGREE OPTION

A degree in management at Millersville equips students for a variety of roles and to enter the business field at a high-level position upon graduation. - Apply leadership skills to promote supportive communication and ethical behavior, and improve employee productivity.

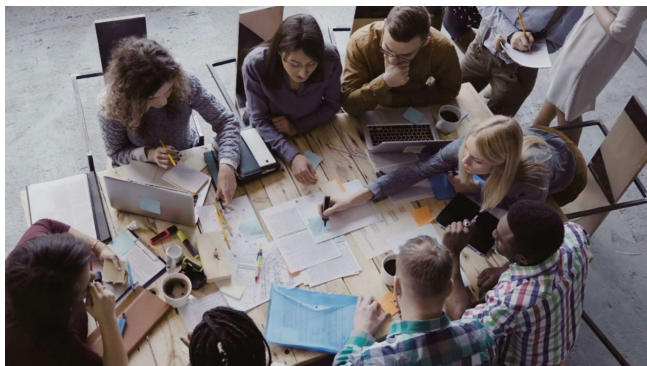
ACCREDITATION
