To avoid any possible conflict of interest, a one-to-one teaching assignment (i.e., Independent Study or Individualized Instruction) or supervisory assignment (i.e., co-operative education or internship) resulting in extra pay compensation is prohibited for a faculty member when it concerns either his/her spouse or dependent child under the tuition fee waiver policy. Under extraordinary circumstances, this policy may be waived with prior approval of the Provost and Vice President for Academic Affairs.
