Millersville holds the distinction of being the only higher ed grantee and the largest grantee in Pennsylvania that receives funding from the federally funded Migrant Education Program.



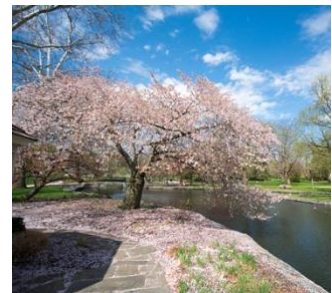
MU Hosts PA Central Region Science Olympiad on March 28
