Careful scheduling in consultation with an assigned advisor is important if the student is to complete the program in eight semesters.

The 18-Credit Studio Art Minor is designed for students who wish to pursue courses in studio art in addition to those of his/her major field. Students must complete ART 133 and ART 142 or 242; one art history course (ART 212, 202, or 203); and three art electives. **ART 100 and 141 may not be counted in a minor.** Students interested in Art Therapy are strongly advised to review the requirements of target graduate programs which may recommend specific courses or require additional courses, beyond the 18-credit minor. With this in mind, we recommend ART 242 (3D Design) over ART 142 (2D Design). The extra ART XXX course in fall of year 3 is not required for the minor but may be necessary if a graduate program's requirements cannot be met with the 18-credit minor. Some specifically recommended elective courses for those aspiring to study Art Therapy include Experimental Photography (ART 167), ceramics (ART 295), Painting (ART 352), and Collage (ART 368).
