***G3 Elective:** SOC 101 (Intro), SOC 210 (Soc of the Family) or SOC 211 (Soc Problems), if Criminology Minor, must take SOC 101; SOWK 305 (Child Welfare), 306 (Aging), 307 (Health Care), 308 (Alcoholism), 309 (Mental Health) , 313(Family Violence)

***Perspectives/Diversity Req:** Choose from: PSYC 318 (Psyc of Racism), SOWK 350 (Encounters in Human Diversity), SPED 330 (Discrim/Oppression of Dis.), EDUC 433 (Gender & Race), COMM 317 (Intercultural Comm), SOWK 313 (Family Violence, but is only P)

Psyc Electives: PSYC 329 (IO), 427 (Childhood Disorders, SPRING), 454 (History- FALL)- if going to grad school, 454 Strongly recommended for preparation for Psyc GRE

*****PSYC 495:** Students may complete up to 6 total credits to count toward Psychology Major
