Prospective graduate students who do not have an undergraduate degree in psychology and intend to apply to the Master's in Clinical Psychology or School Psychology Programs are strongly encouraged to consider the post-baccalaureate certificate program. Admission to either of the programs requires a minimum of 18 undergraduate semester hours in psychology as well as success completion of other admissions criteria. The certificate program does not ensure admission to either program.

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### ADMISSION POLICY AND CERTIFICATE REQUIREMENTS

1. Students must have earned a bachelor's degree in a discipline other than Psychology and did not complete a minor in psychology.
2. Non-degree and continuing education students must be admitted to the certificate program by the Office of Admissions.
3. Certificate program requires a minimum of 18.0 credit hours. Course requirements below total 19 credit hours of required courses and do not include prerequisite courses.
4. Students must earn a B- or higher in all courses that count toward the certificate.
