- 2. Non-degree and continuing education students must be admitted to the certificate program by the Office of Admissions.
- 3. Certificate program requires a minimum of 18.0 credit hours. Course requirements below total 19 credit hours of required courses and do not include prerequisite courses.
- 4. Students must earn a B- or higher in all courses that count toward the certificate.
