#### REQUIREMENTS AND POLICIES FOR THE BA SOCIOLOGY MAJOR

#### A. Policies for Admission to the Major

- 1. New freshmen must have the required SAT scores or class rank as determined by the University Administration.
- 2. All other students (internal and external transfers) must:
  - -complete SOCY 101 (or an equivalent course) with a C or better,
  - -complete MATH 130 (or an equivalent course) with a C- or better,
  - -obtain a minimum CQPA of 2.0 and a QPA of at least 2.0 in courses required for the major,
  - -Internal transfers, additionally, must have completed 15 semester hours at Millersville University.
- 3. Students who meet the above criteria may apply for admission to the Sociology major and will be admitted if space is available.

## B. Policies for Retention in the Major

- 1. University requirements for retention.
- 2. Majors must maintain a minimum CQPA of 2.0 overall and in the major. If either QPA falls below 2.0, the student has one semester to re-establish a 2.0, after which time the student will be dismissed from the major if either QPA remains below 2.0. A student who has been dismissed may petition the department to be readmitted after they have satisfied the minimum retention requirements. Students will be readmitted on a space available basis.
- 3. A student must earn a minimum grade of C in SOCY 101: Introduction to Sociology, a minimum grade of C- in MATH 130: Elements of Statistics, and a minimum grade of C- in SOCY 302: Social Statistics before taking courses for which these are prerequisites. A student who does not earn the necessary grade in these prerequisite courses by the second attempt will be dismissed from the Sociology major.
- 4. The Departmental Academic Review is a mandatory, non-graded activity designed primarily to enhance our departmental advising. Students cannot "fail" the review, and no student will be dismissed from the department based on a poor performance. The review will take place after the completion of 45 semester hours but no later than the semester following the completion of 60 semester hours. It is the student's responsibility to contact their advisor to schedule the Academic Review after the completion of 45 semester hours. The review consists of a half-hour interview with the student's advisor and possibly the department chair. The student is required to submit an essay on their career goals and a resume to the advisor one week prior to the scheduled conference. If the student fails to participate in the review, they will be placed on probation-in-the-major for one semester, during which time they will be given a final opportunity to complete the Academic Review. Failure to complete the review during the probationary period will result in the student being dismissed from the major.

## C. Policies for Completion of the Major

1. Completion of all University curricular requirements.
