Maximum of two courses per summer term. Advanced Standing students must take 2 courses in each summer term. Advanced Standing students complete 4 electives.

Students can take electives in either summer term or during winter terms (if available). Millersville uses Summer 1 and 2 while Shippensburg uses Summer A and B. Summer 1/A begins in May and Summer 2/B begins in July.

Financial aid may be contingent on registering for a minimum number of credits. Students should consult with the Financial Aid Office to ensure eligibility for financial aid.
