*** ELECTIVES:** Regular Standing students need 3 elective courses for the MSW degree. Students can take electives in the term or terms that best fit their program of study. Students should work with their Advisor to plan for electives required for certificates, certifications, or dual degrees. Not all electives may be available to Regular Standing students before Specialization Year.

**** SOWK 511:** In the MSW Program, if this class is not taken in the first summer session, it must be taken in the first winter session.

SUMMER TERMS: There are two summer sessions: one begins in May, and one starts in July. Millersville uses Summer 1 and 2, while Shippensburg uses Summer A and B.
