Common Transfer Student Concerns

HOW DO I TRANSFER MY CREDITS?

Arrange to have your official transcript(s) sent to the Millersville Admissions Office directly from all colleges and universities you've attended. An initial credit evaluation will be included with your admission packet. A comprehensive list of course equivalencies is available online in the transfer section of the admissions page.

HOW DO I APPLY TO MILLERSVILLE AS A TRANSFER STUDENT?

The transfer application at MU is quick and easy. Follow the link below, select the "Millersville University Application" and be sure to choose "Transfer" as your student type on the application.

WHAT SEMESTERS ARE TRANSFER STUDENTS ABLE TO APPLY FOR?

Transfer students can apply for our Fall semester as well as our Spring semester. Our Fall application opens up around August and our Spring application opens up around mid February.

AFTER I APPLY, WHAT ADDITIONAL INFORMATION DO YOU NEED FROM ME? I AM/WAS IN THE MILITARY.

All of our Military service members are encouraged to send us their Joint Services Transcript after they submit their application. Many of our Military students end up receiving college credit for their military courses.

ARE THERE TRANSFER SPECIFIC ADMISSIONS EVENTS?

Yes! We offer guided transition assistance to prospective transfer students at our Coffee and Credits events on campus. SPECIAL TRANSFER ARRANGEMENTS

Dual Admission

This advisement program allows students to apply to Harrisburg Area Community College (HACC) or Reading Area Community College (RACC) and Millersville at the same time. Students are eligible to transfer to Millersville after they complete their associate degree, following the catalog in effect at the time of their admission to the dual-enrollment program. Articulation Agreements

Millersville has transfer articulation agreements with many community college partners. The agreements guarantee transfer of credits upon completion of an Associate Degree and help to facilitate a smooth transition to Millersville.

Transfer Application & Admission Process

1. Admission Requirements

Transfer student admission requires a minimum of 12 transferable credits with a 2.0 or higher GPA. A combined GPA is calculated for students who have earned credits at multiple institutions.

2. Send Official Transcripts

Official transcripts (electronic or paper) must be sent directly from each institution where coursework was attempted. Electronic transcripts can be sent to admissions@millersville.edu. Paper transcripts can be sent to the address below.

3. If fewer than 12 credits earned

Students with fewer than 12 transferable credits earned at the time of application will be evaluated using a combination of official college and high school records and SAT/ACT scores.

4. Confirm Enrollment (Deposit)

Your deposit serves as the key to the next steps in the admission process (invitation to new student orientation, contact with your assigned academic advisor, your Millersville email, registration information, and access to the web-based registration and advisement systems).
