## Academic Policy INDIVIDUALIZED INSTRUCTION

Individualized instruction allows a student to take an established course that is not being offered in a given semester, through a special arrangement with a particular professor. Approval of the professor, department chairperson, and college Dean is required.

- 1. The application form for individualized instruction must be submitted to the Registrar's office to complete the registration process. Courses by individualized instruction are considered part of the student's course load.
- 2. Special Study Assignment forms must be processed for individualized instruction before the end of the add period of the semester in which the special study is undertaken by the student.
- 3. The Collective Bargaining Agreement provides additional stipulations.
